DOCUMENT AMENDMENT

Please note the following amendment to the document entitled “Canadian Society of Forensic Science Drugs and Driving Committee (DDC) Drug Screening Equipment – Oral Fluid Standards and Evaluation Procedures”, effective November 1st, 2017.

In this amendment, the current definition:

“Drug Screening Equipment” means equipment of a kind that is designed to ascertain the presence of specific drugs of interest in the oral fluid of a subject.

will be replaced by the following definition:

“Drug Screening Equipment” means equipment of a kind that is designed to presumptively identify the presence of specific drugs of interest in the oral fluid of a subject for the purposes of a Criminal Code impaired driving investigation.

The purpose of the above-noted amendment is to provide clarification of the purpose for which the DDC developed these standards and evaluation procedures.
